

A large crowd of Speckle Park enthusiasts packed the Bimberdeen Sale Barn, at Meadow Flats, NSW on the 17th September for the Second Speckle Park Spectacular Sale.

A World Record for a Speckle Park Bull at Auction, was reached twice in 10 minutes with two sons of the breed legend "Star Bank Lacerta 68L" bringing \$20,000 and \$18,000 then another son making \$12,000, the very next lot. Frantic bidding from buyers at the sale and online bidders saw the bulls make new records across the board .The average for the 2 year old was up \$1,250 on last year's record prices, to average \$8,950,which was also a new ALL BREEDS auction record for an on property sale!

Representatives for the Spectacular Sale said it was a great day for the Speckle Park Breed, showing the growing demand for the Beef, with commercial buyers dominating the sale. The announcement of the Branded Beef product, "Speckle Park Supreme" played an important part in the commercial demand with the huge .50c premium given for the first cross Speckle beef carcasses playing a large role in the demand for bulls.

The female portion saw 100% clearance and heifers make to \$12,000 for a rising White 3-year-old "Traffic Jam" with a Heifer Calf at side.
